**Assignment:** Critically analyze *A Raisin in the Sun*. Choose One:

- 1) Explain how *A Raisin in the Sun* is a modern tragedy. Consider the setting of the story and the historical context in which the characters are living. Look at how the characters try to succeed and persevere, does each one exhibit a tragic flaw of sorts? Is this Walter Lee's story or something larger? Try to use terminology relating to the Tragedy form made popular with the ancient Greek plays.

How does the family unit rise against outside prejudice? Choose specific historical examples of events to help your essay.
